The application received after the last/due date and incomplete application in any respect will not be considered.

	ii)	Govt. shall not be responsible for damage/injury to the individual, if any, sustained during the Physical Efficiency Test/Journey.
	iii)	The candidates shall have to bring with them writing material (blue / black ball point pen and clip board etc) for Written Test.

	iv)	Candidates should come duly prepared to stay at their own arrangements for the purpose of recruitment.
	v)	Candidates will have to appear for selection test at their own expenses and risk and no TA/DA will be admissible.
	vi)	All eligible candidates will be duly informed about the date and venue of the recruitment through speed/registered post.
	vii)	The candidate finally selected for appointment shall be subjected to chest x-ray, pathological and other required test.
